

NOTICE TO VACATE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF LAW TO CAMP ON PUBLIC OR PRIVATE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF EUREKA. IT IS ALSO A VIOLATION OF LAW TO ENCROACH OR OBSTRUCT ANY PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY. ALL PERSONAL PROPERTY MUST BE REMOVED FROM THIS AREA WITHIN TEN (10) DAYS. ANY PROPERTY REMAINING AFTER 72 HOURS WILL BE REMOVED BY CITY SERVICES.

ANY PROPERTY THAT IS ABANDONED WILL BE **IMMEDIATELY DISCARDED**. ANY PROPERTY THAT IS DEEMED TO BE A HEALTH AND SAFETY HAZARD SHALL BE REMOVED **IMMEDIATELY AND DISCARDED**. THIS NOTICE APPLIES TO ANY PERSONAL PROPERTY THAT IS DEEMED TO HAVE BEEN RELOCATED TO ANOTHER AREA WITHIN THE CITY OF EUREKA OR PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY IN RESPONSE TO THIS NOTICE.

ANY PROPERTY THAT IS REMOVED MAY BE RECLAIMED PURSUANT TO EPD POLICY 804 BY CALLING **(707) 441- 4060** AND SCHEDULING A DATE AND TIME FOR PICK-UP AT THE EUREKA POLICE DEPARTMENT OR AT THE LARGE CONEX BOX LOCATED IN THE NORTH PARKING LOT OF THE BAYSHORE MALL. ANY PROPERTY THAT IS NOT RECLAIMED WITHIN NINETY (90) DAYS OF REMOVAL WILL BE DISPOSED OF.

ANY PERSON(S) FAILING TO COMPLY WITH THIS NOTICE TO VACATE WILL BE IN VIOLATION OF THE CALIFORNIA PENAL CODE, CALIFORNIA STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE AND THE EUREKA MUNICIPAL CODE AND **WILL BE PROSECUTED**.
